Project Ready

Project Ready is an experiential work readiness and interactive personal development program developed by Central Ranges Local Learning and Employment Network. It was first delivered in 2017 to assist disengaged students become re-engaged in their education and ready for their future worlds of work.

Since then, Project Ready has been redeveloped to meet the needs of a wider range of students such as those who have not identified a preferred career path or developed the work readiness skills required to successfully transition to further education, training or employment.

Project Ready is available as a full-year VET program mapped against Certificate II in Active Volunteering. The program is auspiced by selected RTOs and TAFEs (currently IVET) and delivered by a TAE-qualified trainer (known as the Project Ready facilitator). The facilitator has specialist facilitation skills to enable delivery of the Project Ready curriculum using our relationship-based pedagogical approach.



The aim of the 'I am Deadly' program is to motivate and empower participants to continue to engage with education and employment with a work readiness focus.

- To develop in participants the confidence to pursue opportunities
- To deliver real and lasting employment preparation for participants
- To Expand the knowledge and understanding of trade pathways
- To provide a platform for stakeholders to work collaboratively in providing a holistic work readiness program that connects participants to employers and provides real exposure to the workplace
- To build a series of 'case studies of success' that will enhance the aspirations of young Koorie people.

Stage 1 - Trade Taster Program. To be delivered one day per week in Term One 2022

Stage 2 - 'I Am Ready' Work Readiness Program. To be delivered one day per week in Term Two 2022

Stage 3 - Work Placement. To occur in Term Three 2022

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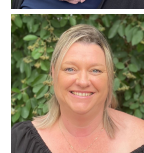
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
